Christmas Holiday Closing



The surgery will be open as usual up to and including Friday 24th, but there will be no Fetlar surgery that day. We will hold a morning surgery in Yell instead. The health centre will be closed on Saturday 25th, Sunday 26th, Monday 27th and open again, as per normal, on the Tuesday 28th, but will

not have a Cullivoe clinic that day. We are closed again on Saturday 1st, Sunday 2nd, Monday 3rd, and reopen on Tuesday 4th. Again, there will be no Cullivoe clinic that Tuesday. If you require a doctor urgently between these times phone the health centre as usual, on 01957 702127, where a recorded message will inform you where the doctor can be contacted.

Please make sure that you have enough medication to see you through the festive season.

Also please be aware that in severe weather conditions the "Post People" may not be able to deliver your tablets to you. If you do not receive medicines when you expect to, and you need them urgently, **please contact the surgery** and **NOT** the post office. To allow adequate time for your medicines to get to you via the post, please remember to order them at least 48 hours before you need them.

Prescriptions

We will be putting in a prescription re-order slip in with everyone's repeat prescriptions in the future. You can still order drugs on the phone if you wish, or via our website. One advantage of the website is that it can be done at anytime you remember, and once set up, is very easy to use. Any questions, just speak to the reception staff.
